Menus- Breakfast and lunch menus are due no later than Monday, October 16th.

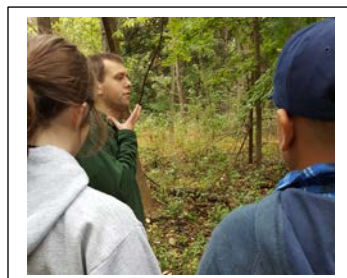
Picture Day- School picture day is Friday, October 20, 2017. Please hold on to your order forms until Friday.

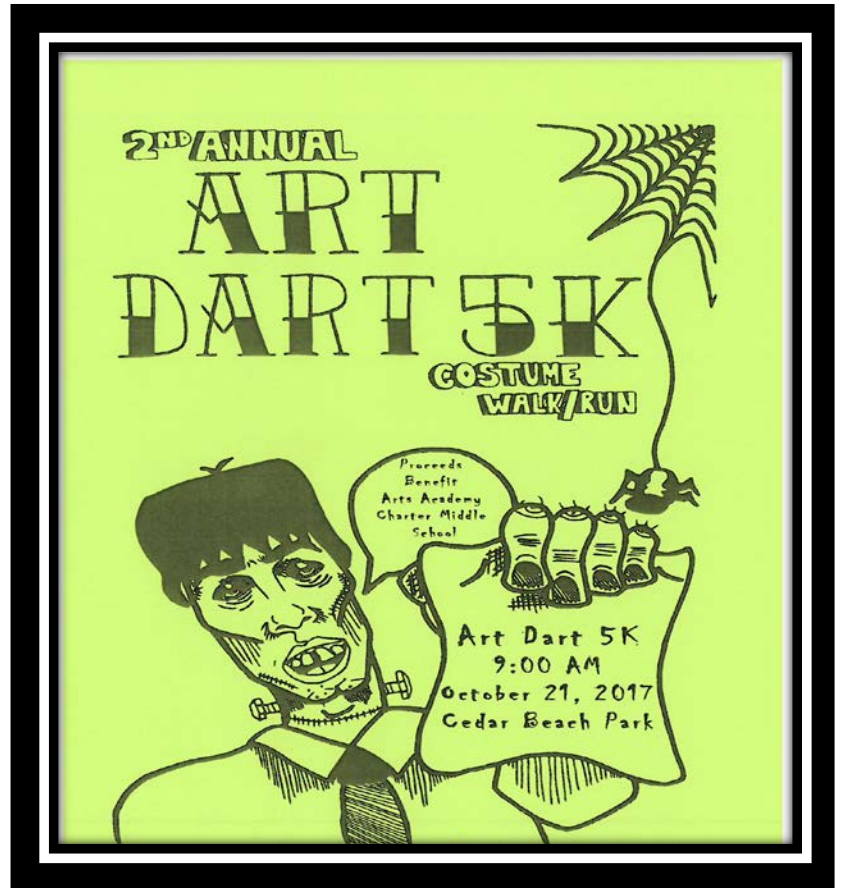
